Registration can be completed on line by visiting our new website: www.camplambec.com or you can send the enclosed registration form to the CAPNWP office at PO Box 279 Zelienople, PA 16063. (There is a downloadable form on the website for mailing purposes.)

Payment can be made by credit card, debit card or by check. An \$80 deposit is required to hold your individual or family registration. You can then make periodic payments or a final payment when you arrive at camp.

Payments paid in full by May 15th receive a \$25 discount.

Directions to Camp Lambec

Camp Lambec is located at 13110 Old Lake Road, East Springfield, PA 16430

Check in time is 3:00 p.m. on Sunday and all camp programs finish on Friday evening unless arrangements have been made with the Transitional Director.

From Pittsburgh & the South: Take I-79 North to Exit 178 onto I-90 West on the south side of Erie. Stay on I-90 West for 15 miles to Exit 6 and turn right at the end of the ramp. Follow the directions "From I-90" below. ***

From the East: Take I-90 West to Exit 6; turn right at the end of the ramp. Follow "From I-90" below. From Cleveland and the **West:** Take I-90 East, enter into PA. Stay on I-90 East to Exit 6, turn right at the end of the ramp. Follow "From I-90" below. **

***From I-90. Go North on PA 215 for about 4 miles, cross US 20, cross PA 5 (PA 215 ends at PA 5). Go .2 mile; bear left at Peggy Gray's Candy Store. Go 1.5 miles on Old Lake Road to the Lambec entrance on the right. Look for white fence & red barn.

Camp Lambec is 92 acres of God Space along the shore of Lake Erie with beach access! Campfires, outdoor worship spaces, a pond for fishing, paddleboats, canoes, sports fields and courts, child playground, bikes, and more for all ages. Campers are housed in cabins with multi-rooms, bunks, front porches, and many with toilet and sink. There is a Recreation Hall, Indoor Chapel, Dining Hall, and Bathhouses.

Staff & Volunteers

All of our staff and volunteer counselors for each program are servant leaders. Each have background clearances and receive training in hospitality and compassionate care for campers. They provide age-appropriate Worship and Faith Exploration opportunities. Many have been involved in camp ministry for multiple years.

Disciple Mission Camp / June 18-23

Looking for a camp experience with an emphasis on service? Want to provide a youth mission experience that doesn't require a lot of planning or a huge group? Camp Lambec's Disciple Mission Camp is a week for 6th-12th graders to grow through compassionate service to our neighbors in the city and county of Erie. Different groups will visit mission worksites in the morning and afternoon with a mix of camp activities interwoven. Shared meals, worship, games, and faith formation will help us build servant disciples. Both individual campers and church groups are welcome to enroll.

Wet-N-Wild & Wet-N-Wilder / June 25-30 /

Entering Grades 3-6 & 7-12

Wet N Wild / Wetter N Wilder is overflowing with fun, faith, and adventure! Wet N Wild is for campers entering grades 3 – 6 and Wetter N Wilder is for campers entering grades 7 – 12. All campers have age-appropriate activities with plenty of fun in the sun to go around! It's a water themed camp so swimming, water games, and a trip to a local water park are camper favorites! Campers also enjoy Bible study, worship, and time around the campfire.

Sports & Adventure Camps / July 2-7 / Entering Grades 3-5 & 6-8

Come learn to play and enjoy the re-creation of your spirit this summer through sports and adventure activities. This camp is all about "playing the games" and learning to enjoy the adventures of the outdoors. We will "play" various games on a variety of fields and courts during the week, and explore the adventures along trails, on the pond, at the



beach, and along our new challenge course. This is not a skills development camp but you will learn how to play croquet, volleyball, soccer, gaga ball, pickle ball, corn-hole, disc-golf, horseshoes, and all the water sports the camp offers.

Music Camp / July 9-14 / Grades 4 – College Freshmen

Music is a great way for young people to come together! It is the language of the soul that speaks to campers and the world. Over 100 campers join in learning and playing music together while hearing the Gospel and enjoying the fellowship through summer fun activities along the shore of Lake Erie. Bible Study, worship, sports, and music abound!

Experience this unique intergenerational camp with all ages coming together to relax, swim, bike, paddle canoes and boats, fish in the pond, engage in crafts, share in faith exploration activities and worship services and vespers. Glide down the water slide, play field and porch games, float on the lake, share stories around campfires, eat smores, and embrace themed activity evenings, and just have fun with fellow disciples during this week of soul energizing activities.
